Message from our Menahel

In this week's פרשת תרומה, the תורה elucidates the contributions כלל ישראל made of raw materials to help construct the משכן.

"וזאת התרומה אשר תקחו מאתם זהב וכסף ונחשת...אבני שהם ואבני מילואים לאפד ולחשן"

"This is the portion that you should take from them: gold, silver, copper.... shoham stones and filling stones, for the Eiphod and the Choshen" ("נמות כ"ה:ג',ז')

The אור החיים הקדוש questions the seemingly puzzling order in which the materials donated to the משכן are enumerated. By starting with gold, silver, and copper, the order seems to be based on the monetary value of the items. However, the last two items that are listed, the שבני מילואים and אבני מילואים were actually the rarest and therefore the most valuable so shouldn't they have been mentioned first?

The אור החיים הקדוש brings three answers. In his last answer, he explains that the order of the items is not based on their value but rather the toil and effort exerted in preparing and bringing the donations. The אבני אבני מילואים and אבני מילואים were brought by the ענני הכבוד were the rarest and most valuable, no effort was exerted by בני to acquire them.

The תורה is teaching us an incredible insight into how we should value things. The most important value is toil, effort, and מסירת נפש. It is imperative that we inculcate into our talmidim the concept that the only valuable measure of success is effort and toil. Whether we succeed or not is in 'ה's control. Our חיוב is to put in the effort to succeed.
